



Egypt COVID-19 Travel Update – July 1, 2021

Americans aged six and older are allowed to enter Egypt with written documentation of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 96 hours of arrival, however, there have been reports of those with tests older than 72 hours being denied entry. Proof of health insurance is required, according to the U.S. Embassy in Egypt. Travelers to Sharm el Sheikh are allowed to arrive without a PCR test, but they must be tested upon arrival and quarantine until a negative test result is received.
