



Russia COVID-19 Travel Update - February 26, 2021

Entry is suspended for all foreign nationals except close family members of Russian citizens, permanent residents, diplomats and their family members, highly qualified sports professionals, and persons participating in installation and technical support of foreign equipment approved by a government agency.

Highly-Qualified Specialist (HQS) employees are allowed entry provided their entry has been approved by the respective Ministry and by the Federal Security Service and Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia.

Nationals and residents of Switzerland, Finland, Japan, Egypt, United Arab Emirates, Turkey, India, Belarus, Serbia, Kazakhstan, South Korea, Kyrgyzstan, Ethiopia, Seychelles, Vietnam, Qatar or Tanzania are exempted from the entry restrictions provided they arrive from Switzerland, Finland, Japan, Egypt, United Arab Emirates, Turkey, India, Belarus, Serbia, Kazakhstan, South Korea, Kyrgyzstan, Ethiopia, Seychelles, Vietnam, Qatar or Tanzania.

All travelers arriving on regular, scheduled flights must present a negative COVID-19 test result, issued no more than 72 hours before arrival.

Travelers who arrive with no test results must take a test within 72 hours of arrival. If the test result is positive, the traveler will be required to self-quarantine for 14 days.
