



Uganda COVID-19 Travel Update – August 4, 2021

Tourists may visit with a negative PCR test taken no more than 120 hours before their flight into the country. All travelers will be given a Covid-19 test at their own expense (no more than \$65) upon arrival, regardless of age. They will then be taken to a holding area, or they may check into a designated hotel, to await their results. The government also requires departing passengers to present a negative test taken not more than 72 hours before they are scheduled to leave the country.
